Fees: (Includes AKC Recording and Service Fees)

****Note:** Friday evening, Saturday morning, and Saturday afternoon are each three separate trials. For example, if you wish to enter Rally Novice B on Friday evening, Saturday morning and Saturday afternoon, **your total entry fee will be \$75.**

No money orders. Pay by check only.

Closing: Entry must be received by Wednesday, April 10, 2019 at Noon at the home of the Rally Trial Secretary; after which, entries cannot be accepted, cancelled, substituted or revised as noted in Chapter 11, Section 6 of the AKC Show/Trial Manual.

Waitlist: A waitlist will not be kept for these trials.

Acceptance: Entries will be accepted in the order received; until the judging time limit, entry limit or closing date and time is reached.

Non-Acceptance: Entries will not be accepted by email, telephone, hand delivered, if a delivery signature is requested, or if sent "postage due." Entries will not be accepted if not on an Official AKC Entry Form or without the Agreement and Rules. Entries will not be accepted without entry fees, if unsigned, if incomplete or if any condition as to acceptance is specified.

Refund Policy: A refund of entry fee (minus \$10 per entered class of withdrawn dog) may be obtained for injured dogs or for bitches that come in season after the closing date of the show. To request a refund, a veterinarian's certificate must be received by the Rally Trial Secretary at least one half hour before the show opens.

No refunds will be given for:

- Cancellation, substitution or correction of entry after the closing date.
- If a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by the judge.
- If a dog is barred from competition by action of the Show Committee.
- If it is impossible to open or complete the show because of weather, riots, civil disturbances or other acts, beyond the control of WSDTC.

Acknowledgment: Entries will be acknowledged as soon as practical. If you have not received an acknowledgment one week after closing, please notify the Rally Trial Secretary.

Liability: WSDTC will not be held responsible for damage, injury or loss of property either in the building or on the grounds. Children are the responsibility of their parents and must be under control at all times.

Waiver of Rights for Animals in Distress: The Winston Salem Dog Training Club reserves the right to remove any animal in distress from a parked vehicle or crate and all persons attending this dog show hereby waive any claim for damages against the club for such removal.

Judging: Judges will not wait for any handler holding up a class. Owners and Agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the ring when their classes are called to be judged. Consult the judging program and check-in at least 15 minutes before your class. Handlers should notify the table steward of any judging conflict and must accept the judge's decision, whether or not to revise the judging order.

Prizes: A qualifying score is required for all ribbons and prizes offered. Prizes will be awarded at the trial, and those prizes that are not claimed will be forfeited. No prizes will be mailed.

Transfers: The rally trials will allow transfers in accordance with AKC's obedience and rally rules. Transfers will only be permitted provided the class is available and the maximum number of dogs per day for that judge has not been reached. The deadline for transfers is no later than 30 minutes prior to the start of the entire trial for which the transfer is being requested. *(For example, if the trial starts at 8AM, no transfers can be submitted after 7:30AM.)* When possible, exhibitors are strongly encouraged to submit transfer information to the trial secretary before the day of the trial:

- Those wishing to make a transfer for the first day they are entered in the trial weekend should email their transfer request to the trial secretary by Tuesday, April 23, 2019.
- Day-to-day transfers should preferably be submitted in-person to the trial secretary before leaving that day's event. *(For example, if you finish a title on Friday and wish to move up for Saturday, you should submit your transfer before leaving Friday's trial.)*

Dogs: Only dogs entered in the trial are allowed in the building. Unless being judged, dogs are not allowed in the rings, and must be on leash or crated. Dogs are not allowed in the building overnight. Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations. Signs will be posted stating where you may walk your dog. Our neighbors have asked that dogs not eliminate on their grass. Violators of these conditions will be asked to leave the trial.

Crating: We have a separate crating room with ample space for our rally trials. Crate identification is encouraged. No X-pens are allowed at the trial site.

Only entered dogs are allowed inside the WSDTC building

Food: No food will be available for exhibitors on Friday or Saturday. Bring your own lunch, snacks, and drinks. A map of nearby restaurants is available on the club website: <http://www.wsdtc.org/events.php>

Parking: WSDTC will provide parking at our building, with overflow parking next door. We have no overnight parking. Our parking area is compact: there is no parking for campers, RVs, or oversize vehicles. The owner of the next door overflow parking area has asked that dogs NOT use their yard for elimination.

Ring Size: 40 X 60 (2400 square feet)

Trial Hours and Information

Friday Evening: Trial starts at 4:00pm. The building will open to rally exhibitors for setup at 3:00pm. Please do not arrive earlier than 3:00pm.

Saturday: Trial hours are 8am-6pm. The afternoon trial will start approximately 30 minutes after completion of the morning trial. The afternoon trial will not begin before 12 Noon. After entries close, the judging program will list a specific start time for the afternoon trial.

Class Running Order: Each trial will run in the following order: Master, followed by Excellent B/A, then Advanced B/A, then Intermediate, then Novice B/A. A walkthrough will precede each class.

Jump Height Running Order: Lowest to highest jump height for all three trials.

Directions to Winston-Salem Dog Training Club

From Greensboro and Points East: On Bus I-40W/Hwy 421N, take Exit 6B to get on US 52N (toward Mt. Airy). Take Exit 115B to get on University Parkway South. Go 1.6 miles and turn right onto Bethabara Park Blvd. Go ~1 mile and turn left onto Bethania Station Road (railroad tracks & traffic signal). The club is immediately on the right.

From Statesville and Points West: On I-40 eastbound, keep left at Exit 188 to get on Bus I-40E/Hwy 421S toward Winston Salem. Take Exit 2B and stay left on the exit ramp to get on 67W/Silas Creek Pkwy N. As you approach the second traffic signal (~3.3 mile) Silas Creek Parkway and 67W will split; keep left to stay on Silas Creek. As you continue on, Silas Creek will become North Point Blvd at the 4th traffic signal. At the 5th traffic signal, turn left onto University Pkwy N. At the first traffic signal (convenience store & a car lot are on the corner), turn left onto Bethabara Park Blvd. Go ~1 mile and turn left onto Bethania Station Road (railroad tracks & traffic signal). The club is immediately on the right.
